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10 stages of making medicine

A.	Test: The tablets are tested to make sure they are safe for people to take.
J	Make: The mixture is put through the processing machinery and pressed into a tablet.
A	Recipe: The scientists have decided to turn it into a tablet. Now they need to work out how to create the formulation. This is like creating a recipe.
J	Discover: A new molecule that can treat a disease or symptom is identified. This is called the active ingredient.
t	Package: The tablets are put into packaging that keeps them safe
J	Research: Scientists study what causes a disease or symptom. They run experiments to find a treatment.
A	Mix: The active ingredient in medicine is too small to be used on its own so it is mixed with other ingredients like sugars.
t	Test: Scientists work out whether the molecule can be turned into a tablet, an injection, an inhaler or a cream.
A	Transport: The tablets are transported to hospitals and pharmacies.
	Take: The tablets are given to patients by doctors and nurses. People may also buy the tablets from pharmacies. The medicine is taken.
